Beer Tasting Fundraiser. We had a fun beer tasting fundraiser at Grace Lutheran in Hatfield at the end of July. A good time was had by all and 100% of the proceeds went to the tiny house project!



Site Plan Approval. The site plan for 7979 State Road was approved by the City, allowing us to move forward with plans to obtain the proper permits and also start the zoning variance application process. These steps will take months to get through but at least we are on our way!

Getting Ready to Build. Country Tyme in Colmar (on Route 309) has agreed to build our tiny houses. They have worked with us on a design that we are proud of – an attractive, small cottage with a front porch. They are able to accommodate the requirements for insulation, heating and air conditioning, and wiring that we demand so that residents will be comfortable. We are thrilled that they have agreed to work with us; their work is top notch.

Ongoing Fundraising Efforts. We are immersed in fundraising to be able to obtain the permits we need, prepare the property, and plan and build the tiny houses. With the pandemic, as I am sure you are all aware, the cost of everything has skyrocketed so the price tag for everything is steep these days.
